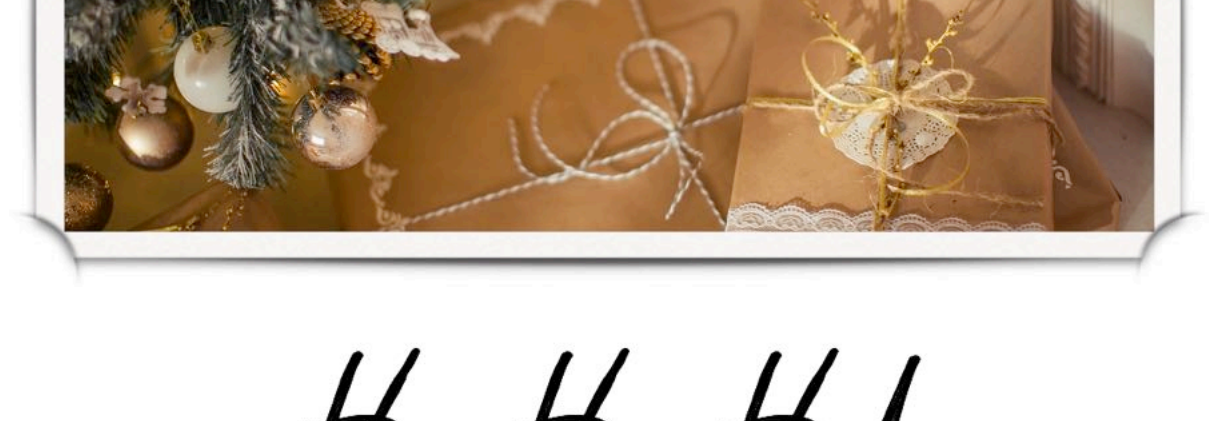

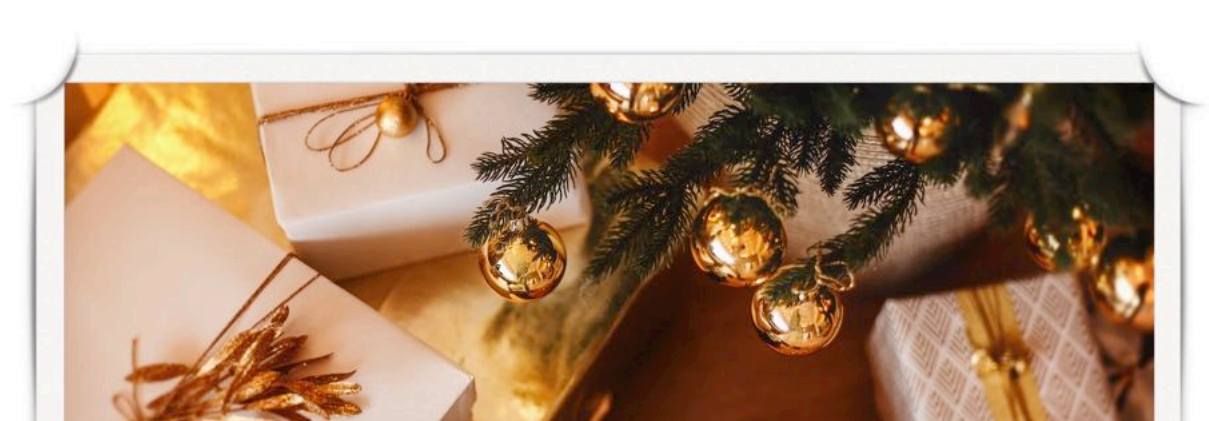
# Ho, Ho, Ho!

## School Carol Concert

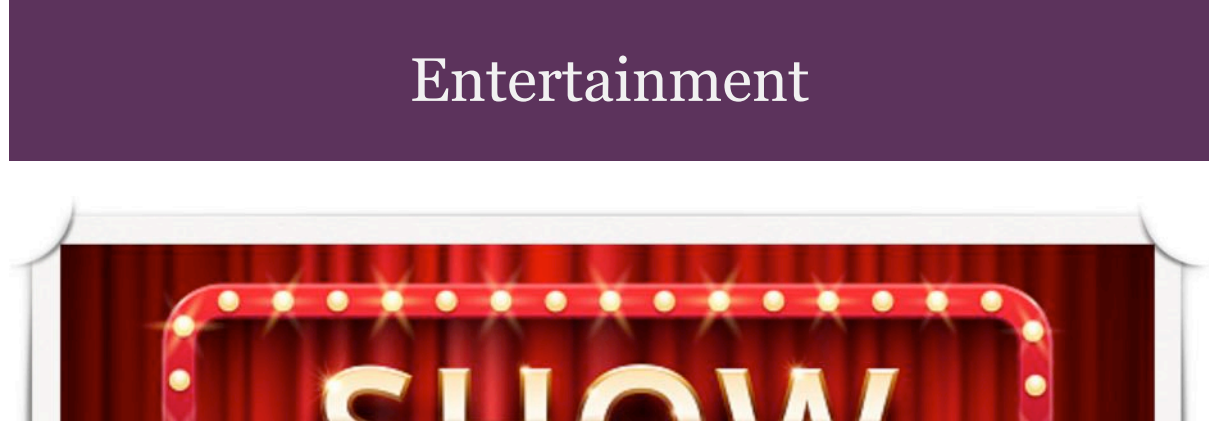


# Christmas Spirit

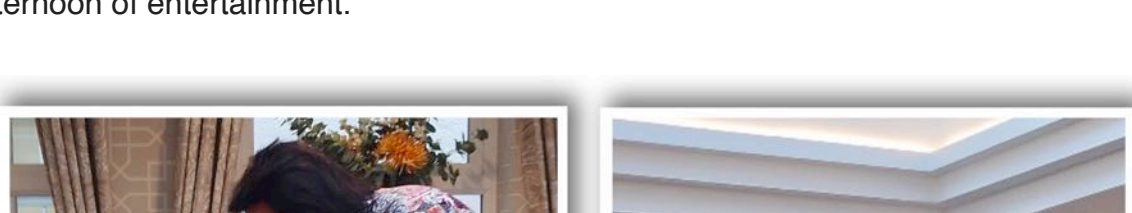

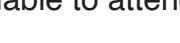
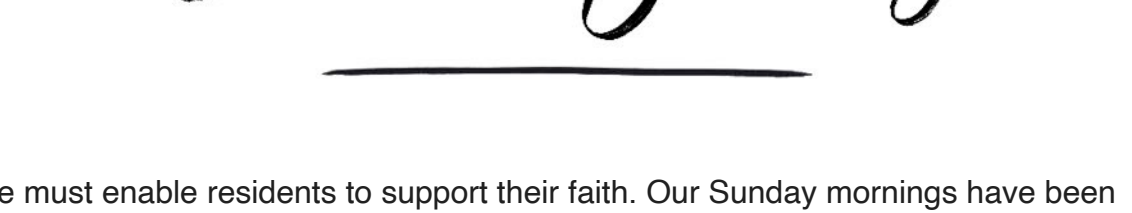


## St Paul's Church

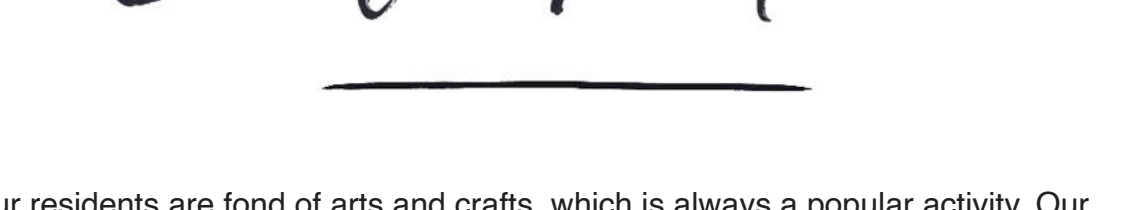

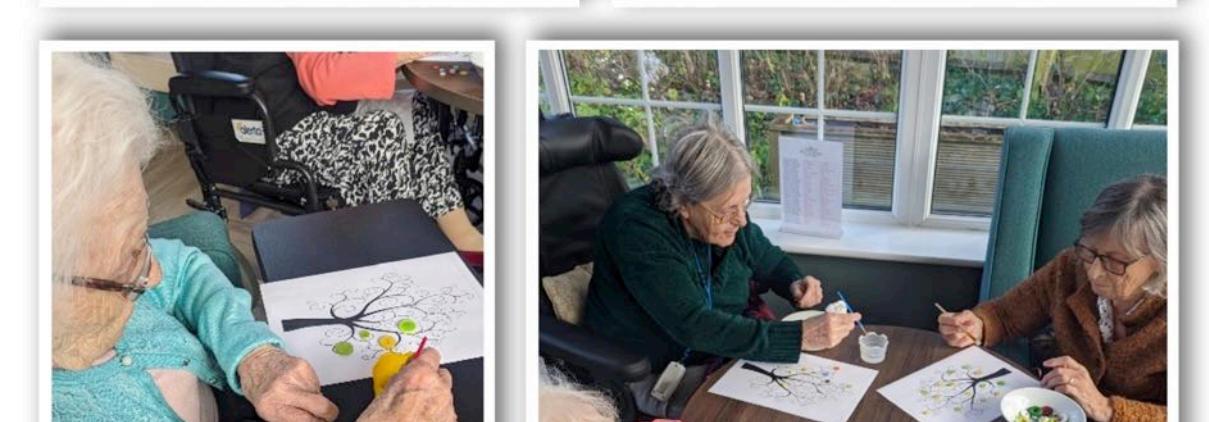


# Creative Freedom!

## Shopping Trip



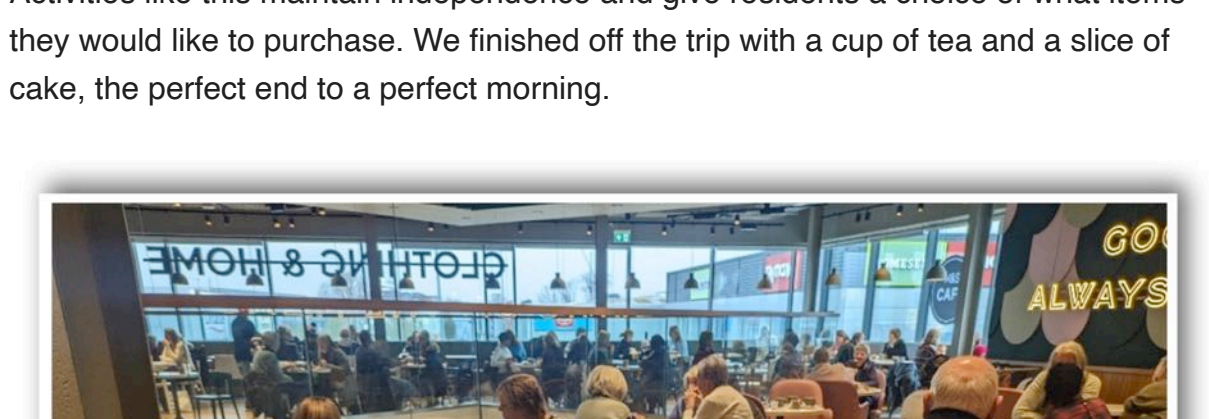
# Retail Therapy

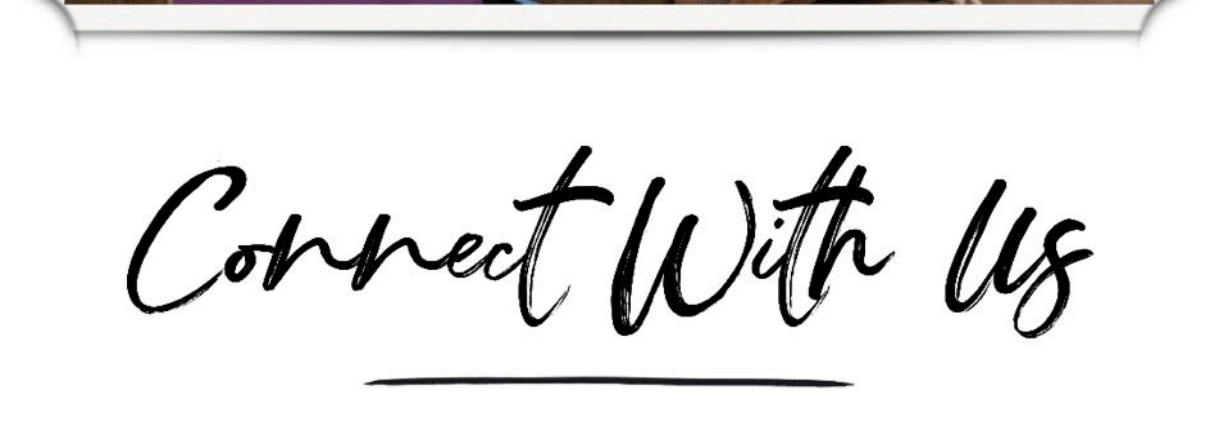
