These visits provide a calm and enjoyable experience, and we look forward to seeing what animals will join us next.




Art Club

These activities play an important role in supporting social interaction, maintaining skills and helping residents feel engaged in daily life.




New Coffee Machine

The coffee machine is now a welcome addition to the home, and residents and visitors can enjoy a drink in the conservatory while taking in views of the garden.




NEWS & UPDATES


